What is Verizon LifeLine Service?

This provides you with dial tone into your home so you have the ability to make and receive calls. There is no difference in the service you receive. You just pay less.

How much does it cost?

Verizon LifeLine Service saves you \$7.00 per month for basic telephone service.

Note: regular phone rates apply for your local, regional and long distance phone calls.

How do I get LifeLine Service?

What about installation?

LifeLine Service can help you with the cost of installing new phone service. New LifeLine customers can save one-half on service connection costs (up to \$30.00) and have 6 months to pay the balance.

Can I get a discount on other Verizon services like Call Waiting, Caller ID and Call Answering?

No. Services like Call Waiting and other optional services are charged at the regular monthly rate.
