**AMENDMENT**

The Bell Atlantic telephone companies<sup>1</sup> hereby amend their comparably efficient interconnection ("CEI") plan for protocol conversion services to add the new underlying basic services listed in the Attachment with the effective tariff references.<sup>2</sup>

The Commission provided for such amendments in its order granting an interim Computer II waiver.<sup>3</sup> That order required the Bell operating companies to amend their existing CEI plans within sixty days in order to continue offering enhanced

services that were not the subject of previously-approved CEI plans.<sup>4</sup>

Although Bell Atlantic has an approved CEI plan for protocol conversion services, several underlying basic services were not being offered at the time the plan was filed and were, therefore, not referenced in that plan. Bell Atlantic will comply with all applicable CEI conditions in providing protocol conversions in connection with the additional basic services.
