Subject: Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: FCC Price Cap Annual Filing for 2022

On June 16, 2022, Verizon^[1] made its Annual Interstate Access Tariff Filing (Transmittal No. 1427) for the Verizon Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16. Under this filing, beginning on or about July 1, 2022, Verizon is increasing certain Presubscribed Interexchange Carrier Charges in Tariff FCC No. 14. In addition, certain End User Common Line Charges in Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, and 16 are increasing. Certain Access Recovery Charges are changing in FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16. Included in this filing is a reduction of the access charges applied to originating Toll Free (8YY) minutes and database queries as ordered by the FCC in WC Docket 18-156. End Office Switching and Shared End Office Trunk Port rates are changing for originating Toll Free minutes in Verizons applicable interstate and intrastate tariffs.
