Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: Verizon FCC Exogenous Cost Change Filing

On September 16, 2022, Verizon^[1] made its Interstate Access Exogenous Cost Change Tariff Filing (Transmittal No. 1429) for the Verizon Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16. Under this filing, beginning on or about October 1, 2022, Verizon is decreasing certain Primary Interexchange Carrier Charge (PICC) rates in Tariff FCC No. 14, certain Subscriber Line Charges (SLC) (also known as End User Common Line Charges) in Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11 and 16, and certain Access Recovery Charges (ARC) in Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16.
