## Subject: Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: ASOG 67 Release and Additional ASR Edits, Effective September 16, 2023

Effective September 16, 2023, Version 67 of the Access Service Ordering Guidelines (ASOG) will be implemented in Verizons pre-order and ordering interface systems for Access services.

During implementation of the ASOG 67 release, Access Ordering and Unified Ordering Model (UOM) will not be available to process transactions from 7:00 PM ET on Friday, September 15, 2023 until 7:00 AM ET on Monday, September 18, 2023.

At implementation of ASOG 67, the field EVC QTY has been added to the EVC (Ethernet Virtual Connection Form - Practice 016).

Further, Verizon will not support the entry of a value of 2 in the EVC QTY field. An entry of 2 will result in an error being returned

Between July 5, 2023 and September 16, 2023, ASOG 67 edits and Verizon custom edits can be accessed through the following Business Rules Links:
