Subject: Addition to DSL Generally Available Terms and Conditions

Description: Effective September 22, 2006, Verizon has made additions and changes to the Generally Available Terms and Conditions associated with the DSL service offering.

The additions being made to the document relate to "Payment and Billing" terms that were omitted from the initial document. These additions had previously been part of the DSL FCC Tariff that was removed on August 14, 2006.

The changes being made to the document are associated with the DRL (DSL over Resold Lines) service offering, which is found in Attachment 2 of the GATC. As of August 15, 2006, DRL service was no longer available to new customers (carriers). Existing customers can continue to purchase the service in those areas that they currently have DRL end user accounts. In addition, effective November 15, 2006, Wholesale Discount Rates will no longer be applied to DRL service.

Attached to this communication is the latest version of the Generally Available Terms and Conditions for DSL service offerings.

Please note that your continued use of Verizon DSL Services will constitute your consent to these new terms under your current term plan.
