SUBJECT: ASR VERSION 23

This is a reminder that the Access Service Request (ASR) document has been revised for ASR Version 23. The status of Verizon's implementation of the Ordering and Billing Forum (OBF) issues included in this Version 23 release is provided in Attachment 1.

ASR Version 23 will be implemented as a "flash cut". In accordance with the guidelines agreed to by the OBF, the following is Verizon's batch file implementation schedule. Please note that the clock times listed below refer to Eastern Daylight Time.

**Verizon SouthEast: (Former Bell Atlantic Service Areas Only)**

- Friday, June 8, 2001: All inbound ASR 22 file transmissions scheduled to be received prior to 5:00 PM will be completed.
- All outbound confirmation file transmissions scheduled to be sent prior to 5:00 PM will be completed.
- Saturday, June 9, 2001: All remaining outbound confirmation files scheduled to be sent after 5:00 PM on 6/8 will be transmitted in ASR 23 format.
- Monday, June 11, 2001: All files sent and received must be in ASR 23 format.

**Verizon NorthEast: (Former Bell Atlantic Service Areas Only)**

- Friday, June 8, 2001: All inbound ASR 22 file transmissions scheduled to be received prior to 5:00 PM will be accepted. After 5:00 PM, inbound files in ASR 22 format will not be loaded.
- All outbound ASR 22 file transmissions will continue as scheduled until close of business (10:40PM).
- Monday, June 11, 2001: All files sent and received must be in ASR 23 format.

**Verizon West: (Former GTE Service Areas Only)**

- Friday June 8, 2001: All inbound ASR 22 file transmissions scheduled to be received prior to 4:00PM will be completed.
- All outbound confirmation file transmissions scheduled to be sent prior to 4:00 PM will be completed.
- Saturday, June 9, 2001: All remaining outbound confirmation files scheduled to be sent after 4:00 PM on 6/8 will be transmitted in ASR 23 format.
- Monday, June 11, 2001: All files sent and received must be in ASR 23 format.
