SUBJECT: ASR VERSION 24

This is a reminder that the Access Service Request (ASR) document has been revised for ASR Version 24. The status of Verizon's implementation of the Ordering and Billing Forum (OBF) issues included in this Version 24 release is provided in Attachment 1.

In accordance with the guidelines agreed to by the OBF, following is Verizon's batch file implementation schedule. **Please note that the following clock times refer to Eastern Standard Time.**

Verizon South: (Former Bell Atlantic Service Areas in Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and Washington, D.C.)

Friday, January 18, 2002: All inbound ASR 23 file transmissions will be accepted up to 5:00 PM. After 5:00 PM inbound files in ASR 23 format will not be loaded.

Outbound acknowledgement files will remain as scheduled in ASR 23 format. Outbound file transmissions will continue as scheduled until 5:00 PM.

Saturday, January 19, 2002: Outbound confirmation transmissions normally sent on Friday at 6:18 PM will be sent on Saturday in ASR 24 format.

Monday, January 21, 2002: All files sent and received must be in ASR 24 format.

Verizon North: (Former Bell Atlantic Service Areas in Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island and Vermont)

Friday, January 18, 2002: All inbound ASR 23 file transmissions will be accepted up to 5:00 PM. After 5:00 PM, inbound files in ASR 23 format will not be loaded.

All outbound acknowledgement files will remain as scheduled in ASR 23 format. Outbound file transmissions will continue as scheduled until close of business day (10:40 PM).

Monday, January 21, 2002: All files sent and received must be in ASR 24 format.

Verizon West: (Former GTE Service Areas Only)

Friday, January 18, 2002: All inbound ASR 23 file transmissions scheduled to be received prior to 4:00 PM will be accepted. After 4:00 PM, inbound files in ASR 23 format will not be loaded.

All outbound acknowledgement files will remain as scheduled in ASR 23 format. Outbound file transmission will continue as scheduled until close of business day (9:00 PM).

Monday, June 21, 2002: All files sent and received must be in ASR 24 format.
