Software enhancements (R3V25) to Verizon West (former GTE) Carrier Access Billing Systems (CABS) are scheduled for production August 31, 2002. With this release we will be implementing the following:

**WA Bill Display**

In order to comply with a ruling recently adopted by the State of Washington Commission, Verizon's access bills, for the state of Washington only, will display Verizon's tariff web address and a toll-free number for tariff inquiries. The two new items will appear on the Remittance page of the bill immediately below the Billing Inquiries line.

**OBF Issue 2056**

OBF Issue 2056 states that the billing processes for facility based LEC/CLEC/CMRS have been changed to be consistent with the UNE process by eliminating common minutes of use billing and the exchange of summary usage records. Verizon will be changing their processes from exchange of summary usage records to exchange of detail usage records. This Issue also states that companies may bill from their own recordings or arrange for the receipt of detail usage records from the recording company. As of usage date 09/01/2002, Verizon will no longer distribute 1150xx summary usage records.

**OBF Issue 2367**

OBF Issue 2367 modified the 110XXX record to add a new field "Send To OCN" in positions 187 - 190. This field will allow companies to identify the recipient billing company in a record exchange process. The Send To OCN is a four-position alphanumeric field that identifies the EC destined to receive the record. The OCN field will be populated with NECA Company Code assigned to the service provider as published in Telcordia's TRA products.

**BOS Version 38**

- Item 2: Pricing Flexibility - Pricing Flexibility allows the ability to offer the same service within a state at different prices based upon specific terms and conditions.
- Item 3: Reciprocal Compensation - This item supports the Reciprocal Compensation of Interconnection and Traffic Termination Agreements for CLECs.
- Item 4: Mid Span Meet Percent - is local interconnection arrangement of meet point with CLECs.
- Item 6: Addition of Two Six-Code to the BDT record 10-35-27-02 - addresses the need to display the Statistics detail at the TSC level.
