Beginning in August 2002, there will be changes to Access Customers' charges for the Primary Interstate Carrier Charge (PICC) in the former GTE companies of Verizon. The change will also be reflected in the Primary Intrastate Carrier Charge for the states of Indiana, Michigan, and Ohio. Verizon will be providing the Terminal Number for derived channel services as described in OBF BOS documentation:

Each active voice terminal will be assessed a Business Multiline PICC per FCC Order 97-158, Section III A. 5. "Assessment of SLCs and PICCs on Derived Channels". Rates for Business Multiline PICC are found in Verizon's FCC No. 14 and FCC No. 16 Access Tariffs as well as the Access Tariffs for the three states.
