On June 18, 2002, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 209 with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to change certain special access rates in Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) subject to Level 1 or Level 2 MSA rating in Tariff FCC No. 14. This filing will result in price changes, including rate increases, which will vary by product and geography. These changes are scheduled to become effective on July 3, 2002.

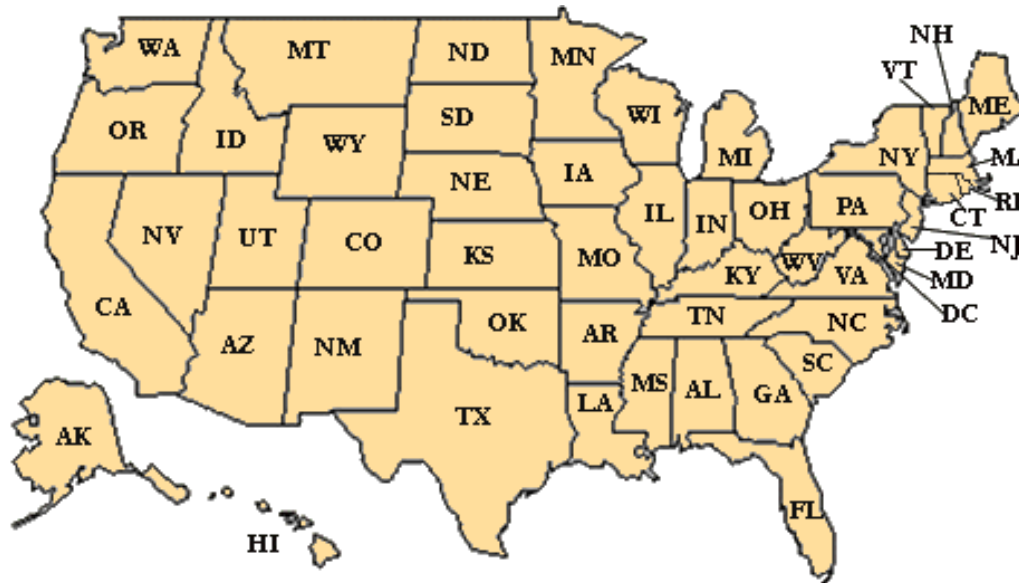
