Dear Customer:

Verizon is in the process of activating our new Tekelec Eagle Number Portability Database (NPDB) in Fort Wayne and Garrett, Indiana and Long Beach and Santa Monica, California. These NPDBs are national in scope, and store all of the ported numbers for all seven U.S. NPAC regions.

On November 13, 2001, Verizon's Network Operations Center (NOC) notified the LARG (LIDB Access Routing Guide) distribution list of the new point codes implemented for our new Tekelec Eagle NPDBs. Verizon intends to complete cutover to the new NPDBs on January 28, 2002. The new point codes listed below should be added to Verizon Wholesale Local Number Portability customers' SSPs (Service Switching Points) and STPs (Signal Transfer Points) as possible responding point codes:

240-127-001 = Fort Wayne IN
240-128-001 = Garrett IN
240-004-001 = Santa Monica CA
240-005-001 = Long Beach CA
