Subject: Proposed Intrastate Switched Access Rate Changes in North Carolina

On May 9, 2003, Verizon filed its Annual Price Plan. In that filing, Verizon proposed reductions to its intrastate switched access rates.

The proposed effective date for these reductions is June 24, 2003. However, the actual effective date is dependent upon approval by the North Carolina Utilities Commission.

The following rate changes are proposed in Verizon's North Carolina Facilities for Intrastate Access Tariff:

1. Reduce the Defined-Radius Discount Plan credit from $-\$0.0380000$ to $-\$0.0242555$.
2. Reduce the Premium Interconnection rate from $\$0.0057543$ to $\$0.0000000$.
3. Reduce the Non-Premium Interconnection rate from $\$0.0037964$ to $\$0.0000000$.
4. Reduce the Premium End Office Switching rate from $\$0.0293402$ to $\$0.0260500$.
5. Reduce the Non-Premium End Office Switching from $\$0.0220052$ to $\$0.01954000$.

The following rate changes are proposed in Verizon's NCUC # 1 Tariff:

1. Reduce the Defined-Radius Discount Plan credit from $-\$0.0855000$ to $-\$0.0734045$.
2. Reduce the Premium Originating Carrier Common Line rate from $\$0.0314722$ to $\$0.0134860$.
3. Reduce the Non-Premium Originating Carrier Common Line rate from $\$0.0236042$ to $\$0.0101145$.
4. Reduce the Premium Interconnection rate from $\$0.0057543$ to $\$0.0000000$.
5. Reduce the Non-Premium Interconnection rate from $\$0.0037964$ to $\$0.0000000$.
