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**RE: TLS Modernization**

Effective March 15, 2008, all Access Service Requests (“ASRs”) for TLS User to Network Interface (“UNI”) and TLS Network to Network Interface (“NNI”) shall be accepted under the Request Type of E or S only. This change also affects subsequent activity ASRs for existing TLS UNI and TLS NNI services. Currently, TLS UNI and TLS NNI requests are accepted under Request Type X or V. The forthcoming changes will not affect existing product components such as the Network Channel (“NC”), Network Channel Interface (“NCI”), and Secondary Network Channel Interface (“SECNCI”); codes for those components identify the service as TLS.

Verizon will allow supplements to existing ASRs under Request Type X or V until they are completed or canceled, provided, however, that Verizon receives the ASR before March 15, 2008,

To effectuate the forthcoming change, Verizon introduces two new Service and Product Enhancement Codes (“SPECs”) to identify the request as TLS UNI; the two new codes appear in bold below. All valid SPEC Codes for TLS UNI Service are listed below:

Verizon will honor the Inquiry-to-Firm process and also accepts a Firm-only process. In the Firm-only process, Verizon will deliver the TLS Switch for the Secondary Location (“SECLOC”) for the TLS UNI on confirmation, ignore any SECLOC provided on the ASR, and transmit the following notice if the SECLOC field is populated on the ASR: “SECLOC will be provided on FOC. Customer-provided SECLOC is disregarded.”

Verizon will provide the installation interval for this service on the Confirmation. Verizon will not honor expedite requests.
