**Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: ASOG 62 Release and Additional ASR Edits Effective March 20, 2021**

Effective March 20, 2021, Version 62 of the Access Service Ordering Guidelines (ASOG) will be implemented in Verizons pre-order and ordering interface systems for access services.

During implementation of the ASOG 62 release, Access Ordering and Unified Ordering Model (UOM) will not be available to process transactions from 7:00 PM ET on Friday, March 19, 2021 until 7:00 AM ET on Monday, March 22, 2021.

Once the ASOG 62 release is in effect, Verizon will support the edits and changes as described below.

Verizon will support the following edit modifications on the Access Service Request (ASR) Form, Contact Section, DSG FAX NO and the DSG EMAIL fields:

- DSG FAX NO - Design Facsimile Number - Modify edit
- DSG EMAIL - Add edit
- DRC - Design Routing Code - Modify edit (Firm Order); Add edit (Service Inquiry)
- FDRC - Facility Design Routing Code - Modify edit

Verizon will not support the expansion from 6 to 25 characters of the UNIT field of the Design Layout Report (DLR) Form.

Verizon will support the addition of the following fields to the following forms:

- IMPCON EMAIL (Implementation Contact Electronic Mail Address) field added to the Contact Section of the ASR Form.
- VTAI (Variable Term Agreement Indicator) field added to the Bill Section of the ASR Form.
- OECVTAI (Other Exchange Company Variable Term Agreement Indicator) field added to the Multiple Exchange Company (Multi-EC) Form, Other Exchange Company Detail Section.

For each of the three new fields described above, Verizon will also add a new field, named definition, definition notes, edits and error messages.

Verizon will apply the value of A (New Term) to the VTAI / OECVTAI field of N Activity (ACT) ASRs submitted without an associated Related Purchase Order Number (RPON) when processing "inflight" service requests.

On ASRs for other Activities[OWTA1] , Verizon will continue to process the "inflight" service request as it was originally accepted. In the event that a Supplement is submitted, Verizon will expect that the VTAI/OECVTAI field is appropriately populated. Failure to populate the field will result in an error being returned.

Verizon will make a documentation only change to the definition of the SITE CON (Site Contact) field of the ASR Form, Contact Section.

Concurrent with the implementation of ASOG 62, Verizon will implement ASR edits to facilitate the ordering of certain product-based services.
